Contribution

As a Seasons Village Volunteer you will make a difference in our community by supporting single mothers and their children who are participating in the Pathways to Prosperity (P2P) program. The P2P Program offers strategic support to single mothers seeking secondary education through a multiphase curriculum to foster a strong foundation for intergenerational prosperity.

Commitment

Participating families gather as a village weekly on Thursday nights for onsite program curriculum for mothers and children and a communal meal. We need volunteers to provide care and curriculum for children ages 1 month to 16 years every week. The children are divided into 3 age groups. Up to 2 years old, 2- 5 years old and 6- 16 years old. Each group needs 1 or more adult volunteers. Youth aged 14 or older are welcome to volunteer combined with an adult. Season's Village is asking Volunteers working with children to consent to a background report and confidentiality agreement to protect the families, the children, and our growing village.

Responsibilities

- Engage children in play and structured activities while maintaining a safe and supportive environment while mothers are in their sessions.
- Appropriately respond to the needs of the children being cared for.
- Help with meals and snacks by making sure each youth is served.
- Helping children with homework (if needed).
- Maintaining a positive, respectful, kind, and non-judgmental view when dealing with the children.
- Light housekeeping to keep Seasons Village clean and tidy, including cleaning spills and wiping down the children's room prior to leaving the office.
- Reporting to staff any concerns or disclosures that arise.

Qualifications

- Passion for working with children of varying ages.
- Dependable, responsible, and capable of working independently.
- Ability to be empathetic and non-judgmental.
- Respect and appreciation for children of diverse backgrounds.
