The P2P Program offers strategic support to single mothers seeking secondary education through a multiphase curriculum to foster a strong foundation for intergenerational prosperity.

### Commitment

**Weekly Flexible Schedule** Participating families are included in the P2P program after an in-depth intake interview process to determine eligibility, qualifications, and commitment. Coach Volunteers will be engaged in strategic ways as a coordinator for one or more families on a weekly basis to support the family's success in the 30-month program. The Coach Volunteer will share our passion for empowering women to self-commit to increase their opportunities for growth. Coach Volunteers background preferred in human services or similar field-based experience, great communication and listening skills, compassion, and an honest respect for diverse choices and situations. Season's Village is asking Volunteers working with children to consent to a background report and confidentiality agreement to protect the families, the children, and our growing village.

### Responsibilities

- Provide on a weekly basis, a minimum of one-hour one-on-one coaching for the mother.
- Partner with the mother to complete secondary degree preparations including:
  - Academics (program applications, degree of choice, school of choice, financial aid application.
  - Social Factors (family, peer influence, engagement, motivation, social connections)
  - Logistics
  - Financial counseling
- Complete Individual and Family Success plan with participant to ensure they stay on track with their goals.
- Help connect family (participant + children) to additional resources if needed.
- Help participants make informed decisions by acting as an advocate when needed.
- Complete a quarterly report of participant's progress.
- Attend Monthly check-ins with Program Director.

- Excellent interpersonal, verbal, and written communication skills.
- Exceptional critical-thinking, organizational, and analytical skills.
